Position: Communications Intern

Description:

The Communications Intern will work closely with program staff to support ongoing environmental justice campaigns around drinking water issues in low-income communities and communities of color in the Southern San Joaquin Valley. Responsibilities will be assigned based on experience, skills, and interest as well as campaign needs.

Responsibilities may include:

- Support ongoing communications work including website, social media, and other digital communications
- Support design and production of visual presentations, memes, graphics, fliers, photographs, printed collateral, and video
- Support event planning and execution

Minimum of 10 hours per week commitment for a 3 month period, or longer, required.

Minimum Qualifications and Skills:

- Interest in social and/or environmental justice
- Good communication skills (writing and oral)
- Solid computer skills (competent in working with MS Office Software, photo/video editing software, esp. Adobe CC; social media platforms, HTML, etc.)
- Able to work independently and in a team environment
- Flexible schedule

Preferred Qualifications and Skills:

- Currently enrolled in or graduated from undergraduate program in relevant field of study
- Previous experience or completion of academic courses related to environmental justice, communications, digital media, etc.
- Experience with: Adobe Illustrator, Canva, Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, iMovie, Windows Movie Maker
- Fluency in both English and Spanish, and ability to provide both written and oral translation is a huge plus, but not required.
- Experience working with low-income communities and/or communities of color in an organizing or service capacity
